**The choir anthem this morning**, which is a setting of the Nunc Dimittis, has been written specially by Roger Hind. Roger writes:

‘Improvising – on the spot composition – arranging and composing music have always been an important part of my life. The congregation at Burstow regularly and uniquely sing my Burstow communion setting which dates from 1993. My new Nunc Dimittis was written over a couple of days earlier this month. The opening melody is used throughout in a variety of keys and realisations. These are linked by short contrasting episodes. Towards the end I have taken the phrase ‘to be a light’ and developed it into a Taizé style chant which alternates with organ improvisations.’
