Café Church report April 2023

Background

Café Church is an all-age, informal church gathering with some structure, but no set rules, providing the space for anyone to come along and enjoy refreshments, company, activities, and Christian worship together. Easter 2023 sees Café Church's first birthday.

Location

Church Hall, Smallfield

Time

3pm, every second Sunday in the month, excluding August. The second Sunday in December accommodates the usual Smallfield carol service.

Format

Tables are set up café style towards the kitchen end of the hall and refreshments are served. Craft and activity tables are set up at the other end of the hall.

As people arrive, they are welcomed, encouraged to take a seat, have a chat, share some refreshment, and do some activities.

Somewhere between 3.30-3.45pm, everyone gathers to sing some songs and listen to a short bible message.

Café Church meetings

Since the launch on Good Friday 2022, Café Church has met every month except August (summer holiday) and December (carol service). Broadly speaking Café Church meetings have mirrored themes and bible readings used in other church services on the same day. Themes and activities were as follows:

Key observations and learning

- Café Church provides a relaxed, friendly atmosphere for informal worship.
- A core of around 25-30 Café Church regulars has emerged, who attend every month. In addition, there are a range of others who have attended several times during the year, meaning the attendee numbers have been good each month. Both Good Friday Café Church meetings have seen bumper numbers.
- It is noticeable that Café Church brings together people who would perhaps not normally meet.
- Feedback has been positive. Many enjoy the art and craft activities. Some Café Church attendees have said they appreciate the opportunity to meet socially and for worship on a Sunday afternoon, as it breaks up the weekend when they would normally be on their own.
- Less is more we don't require lots of planned activities, just a few suggestions. Colouring appears to be a popular activity with all ages. Placing colouring sheets and pens/pencils on the café tables has gone down well. It has also been good to have other activities that can be brought easily to people sitting at the café tables, such as making bead crosses and fish, origami and collage.
- Volunteers are essential to enable Café Church to run smoothly and huge thanks go to all involved. There has been great support from a team of volunteers in the kitchen helping with refreshments, setting up and tidying away, playing music to accompany the songs and the planning team.
- An important aspect of the Café Church planning originally was to ensure the format was easily replicable every month, so that it doesn't necessarily rely on just one or two people. While this has broadly been achieved, new volunteers are always welcome.
