Treasurer’s Report 2023

Thank you once again to all supporters of St. Mary’s who pay by standing order, knowing how much your regular income helps a great deal with trying to budget.

We spent £73,896.23 on refurbishment at school and since the year end we have spent a further £16,709.79 on this.

We held two fund raising events this year: a plant sale and a barn dance. The two events made a combined profit of £1,640.

Our Parish Support Fund was £17,691; we have been increasing this by 3% a year for the last three years, this is much appreciated by the diocese.

General collections are still fairly low but hopefully they will improve when congregations also improve.

This year we again had greater payments over receipts, the vast majority of this was due to school refurbishment costs.
