

Electoral Roll Renewal

This formal announcement applies to each of the three churches that together form the Windmill United Benefice.

Notice is given that under the Church Representation Rules (CRR) a new Church Electoral Roll is being prepared. Every person who wishes to have their name entered on the new Roll, whether it is entered on the present Roll or not, is requested to apply.

An application form for enrolment can be obtained from the Church Electoral Roll Officer and forms will be made available in each church. Under the CRR, a lay person is entitled to have their name entered on the roll, if the person meets specific criteria mentioned on the application form.

In order to be entitled to attend the annual parochial church meeting (APCM) and to take part in its proceedings, you must return the completed and signed Application Form for enrolment by the date given below for each parish.

After the closing date for application in time for the APCM, the new Roll will be published by the Parochial Church Council (PCC) in a prominent place on church premises for at least 14 days and a copy of the Roll will be available for inspection on a reasonable request being made to the PCC.

Any error discovered in the roll should at once be reported to the Church Electoral Roll Officer.
